Further to your letter regarding the Scarborough dunes and roads, I understand the State Government has stopped the planned roads through the dunes and this is a great outcome for the community members who have supported protecting them.

However, it is disappointing that the State Government has now clawed back funds from the redevelopment project as a result. The City of Stirling needs to find a suitable solution for better parking and transport options in the area and work with the State Government to fund and implement it.

The high frequency rapid bus 990 is a great initiative, but I have advocated for light rail from Glendalough to Scarborough, which includes a section through Doubleview Ward, and I understand the council are already taking long term measures to re-claim land to accommodate this along Scarborough Beach Road. I would encourage them to speed this up amid the redevelopment.

We also need suitable and significant planning for improving our pedestrian and cycleways, including end of trip facilities in Scarborough. I enjoy cycling and I'm a big supporter of this.
